

# CENTRAL LIBRARY

The Central Library is a great source of information where the students and the faculty immerse themselves in the realm of knowledge. It has huge collection of text and reference books, CD/DVDs, Journals, Magazines and Newspapers pertaining to varied subjects such as History, Economics, Political Science, Botany, Zoology, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Computer Science, English, Telugu, Commerce, Urdu books, General Books and Competitive Books.

The Library has 11535 volumes with 5077 titles of books and back volumes of periodicals. The Library also subscribes to nearly 10 Magazines and more than 6293 e-journals and 1,95,809 E-Books are accessible through N-List, DOAJ. The college librarian has developed a google site to access categorized online e-resources from available internet Open Access Resources by developing through E-Learning portal via college website. Which provides National Digital Library of India (NDL), SWAYAM, CCE, Swayam Prabha, Shodh Sindhu, N-List, e-Pathshala, MHRD Virtual labs and Spoken Tutorial by IIT Bombay and subject wise e-Books, subject wise e-journals, e-Dictionaries, e-Encyclopedias, E-Competitive exam resources, e-Atlases etc. A separate reference section is maintained with Encyclopedias and General knowledge books. Interlibrary loan facility is available with other colleges. The Library following open access system encouraging the user to browse freely in the stock area. It is fully automated using the following Integrated Library Management System.
