## Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

Between

Department of Computer Applications, Government Degree College, Rayachoty  
&

Department of Computer Applications, Government College for Men, Autonomous Kadapa

### Preamble

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into by and between the Department of Computer Applications, Government Degree College, Rayachoty, hereinafter referred to as "GDC Rayachoty," and the Department of Computer Applications, Government College for Men, Autonomous Kadapa, hereinafter referred to as "GCMA, Kadapa." Both departments, recognizing the value of academic collaboration and mutual benefit, agree to establish a cooperative relationship for the purpose of student exchange, faculty exchange, participation in seminars, training programs, library exchange, and providing guidance to students.

### Objectives

The objectives of this MoU are to:

- ❖ Facilitate student exchange programs to enhance learning experiences.
- ❖ Promote faculty exchange to foster academic growth and collaboration.
- ❖ Organize and participate in seminars, workshops, and training programs.
- ❖ Share library resources to support academic research and learning.
- ❖ Provide guidance and mentorship to students from both departments.

## **Scope of Collaboration**

1. **Student Exchange** : Both departments will establish a framework for the exchange of students, allowing them to attend courses, participate in academic activities, and gain exposure to different academic environments.
2. **Faculty Exchange** : Both departments will promote the exchange of faculty members for teaching, research, and professional development purposes.
3. **Seminars and Training Programs** : Joint seminars, workshops, and training programs will be organized to benefit students, faculty, and staff from both departments.
4. **Library Exchange** : Both departments will provide access to their respective library resources, including books, journals, and digital resources, to support academic research and learning.
5. **Guidance and Mentorship** : Faculty from both departments will provide guidance and mentorship to students, helping them with academic and career planning.

## **Implementation**

1. **Coordination Committee** : A coordination committee comprising representatives from both departments will be formed to oversee the implementation of this MoU. The committee will meet periodically to review progress and address any issues.

This MoU will be effective from the date of signing and will remain in force for a period of **FIVE** years. It may be renewed or amended by mutual written agreement of both departments. Either party may terminate this MoU by providing six months' written notice to the other party.


## Miscellaneous

1. Confidentiality : Both departments agree to maintain the confidentiality of any proprietary information shared during the course of this collaboration.
2. Dispute Resolution : Any disputes arising out of the interpretation or implementation of this MoU will be resolved amicably through mutual consultation between the parties.


