REPORT ON REPUBLIC DAY SPORTS MEET – KABADDI TOURNAMENT

Date: 26th January 2020

Venue: College Kabaddi Ground, Government Degree College, Rayachoty

Organized by: Department of Physical Education

Objective:

To celebrate the 71st Republic Day of India with enthusiasm and patriotism, and to promote physical fitness, traditional sports, and team spirit among students through a Kabaddi tournament.

Participants:

Three teams were formed from different academic streams and years:

- **Team A** – BA Students (I, II, III Years)
- **Team B** – BCom Students (I, II, III Years)
- **Team C** – BSc Students (I, II, III Years)

Each team consisted of 12 players (7 on-court and 5 substitutes), selected through internal trials conducted by the Department of Physical Education.

Tournament Format:

- The tournament followed a **round-robin format**, where each team played against the other two.
 - Matches were played in two halves of 10 minutes each with a 5-minute break.

Match 3:

Team A (BA) vs Team C (BSc)

- **Winner:** Team C
- **Score:** BSc – 30, BA – 22
- **Key Player:** **Suresh** – BSc I Year (Excellent defense)

Final Standings:
