International Human Rights Day on 10-12-2025

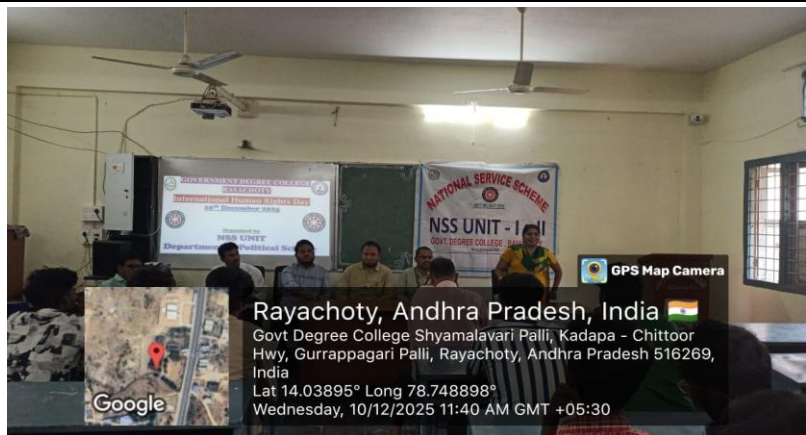
Report on International Human Rights Day
