  - **Lack of digital literacy among some students.**

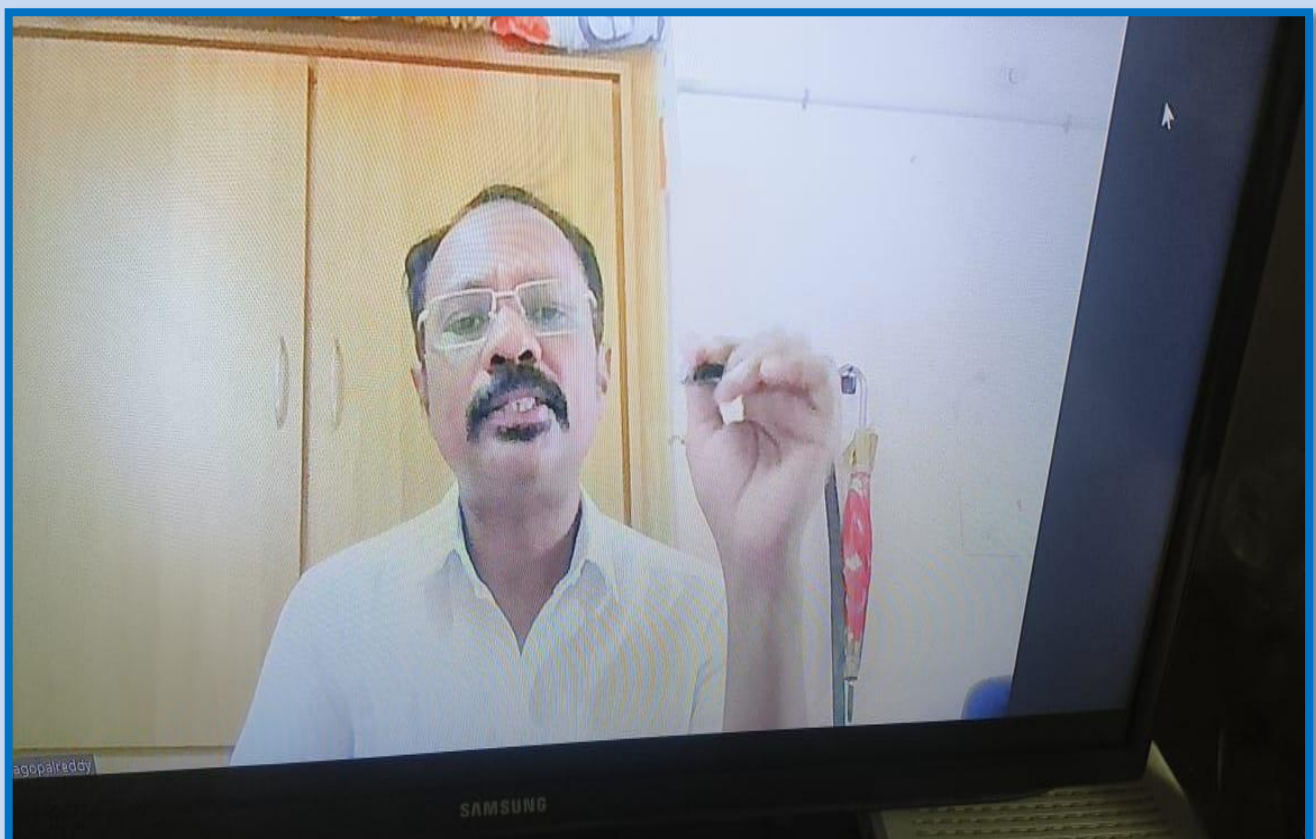
To address these, recorded sessions and offline resources were provided wherever possible.

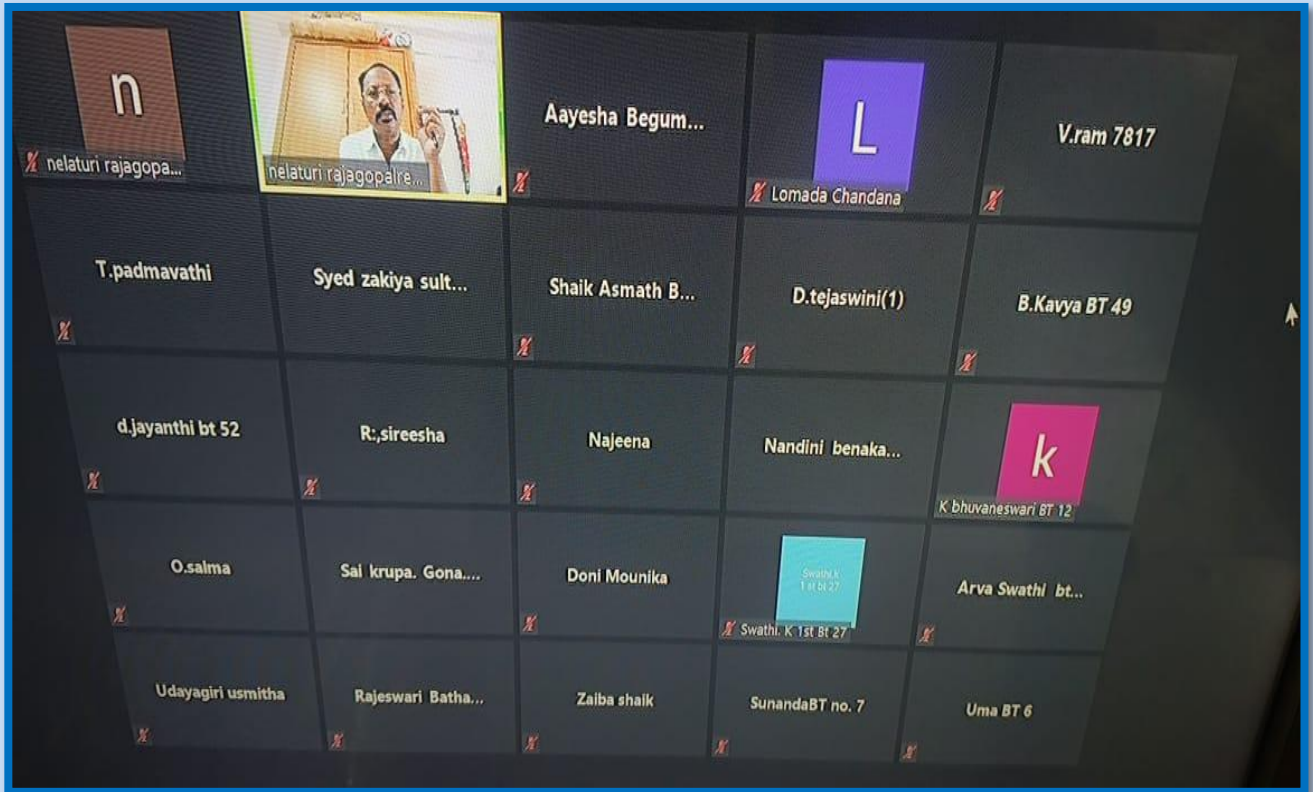
## Outcomes and Feedback
