anemia as they could not get proper blood group in right time. This led to the best practice of

blood donation as many young students, with lot of interest and motivation to donate blood to

save the lives of the poor people, are available with us.

As the demand for blood at hospitals and other health centers can not be met up by the limited number of professional blood sellers, we came forward to start this best practice.

As all our students are above 18 years and below 21 years old and having least of 48 kgs weight , our students are eligible to donate blood.

Through NSS & NCC camps and meetings we inculcate and we educate all the to come forward for donation of blood to the need people. We made the students to understand that their little contribution can prove to be of great help to others .He is also personally benefited by refreshing his blood. Donor can receive a permit which enables him to fetch a bottle of blood within a year , at free of cost , when he requires. God has created life in this world . By donating blood to the life in need of blood ,we save God's children.Hence serving man we serve God.

The Practice:-

People approach us in out of times when students are not available .

Relatives of patients approach us for a particular blood group but that particular blood

group donor may not be available some times.

We faced financial problems while taking the donor to the hospital and bring back him in safe condition.

Some times some students get giddiness after their blood donation in such case some students do not come forward to donate blood .

We could not render our services when people come to us with demand of rare blood group such as o - , AB -, etc.

With proper knowledge on blood donation ,very rarely one parent objected when his ward donated blood.In this connection we gave full awareness on blood donation to the and made him positive on blood donation.

Problems encountered and resources required:-
☑ All students and parents generally have fear of donating blood .But we have arranged counseling classes for them and we make them positive on blood donation.

☑ Sometimes we faced transportation problems . We met such simple problems then and there .

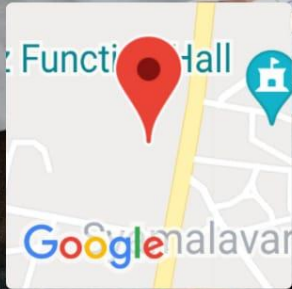

HANDFUL RICE PROGRAM IN OLDAGE HOME

OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM

To provide food assistance to the elderly residents of the old age home who may have limited access to nutritious food and resources.
